Bonhoeffer wrote his Ethics at Ettal in 1941. He was held overnight in a Regensburg prison, and spent his very last days on the road through Schönberg. Over five unhurried days you will stand in those places, stay at the Munich hotel address he used during the war and at the monastery guesthouse at Ettal where he lodged, and meet people in Schönberg who are still connected to his story. Along the way John gives three papers, prepared with input from the Bonhoeffer scholar John de Gruchy.
